CARPOOL AND DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

In order to provide a safe and efficient exit from our parking lot, we utilize a staggered dismissal procedure. The seniors are dismissed at 2:59, the juniors are dismissed at 3:03 and the remaining students are dismissed at 3:06. If your daughter needs to carpool with a senior or junior and therefore be dismissed earlier than her grade level time, please complete **this form**. You can return it via email to Lisa Timmerding (**timmerdingl@ndapandas.org**) Mrs. McLeod (**mcleods@ndapandas.org**), or Mrs. Kirn (**kirnl@ndapandas.org**). If you would like to print it and return it, please drop it off in the office. Additional copies will be available for pick up in the office as well. If your child has a form on file to carpool, she will receive a special lanyard pouch indicating that she can dismiss early. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Also, please see the picture to the left to see available parking for afternoon pick-up. For safety purposes and as advised by the Park Hills Fire Department, it is important to keep the parking lot aisles and all fire lanes clear. PLEASE DO NOT line up for afternoon pick up in the aisles of the parking lot or in fire lanes. All cars picking up after school MUST be either parked in a spot or lined up on the Hilton Drive hill.

UNIFORMS FOR THE 2024-25 SCHOOL YEAR

Approved Uniform pieces are listed below as stated in our Student/Parent Handbook:

Approved Uniform pieces are listed below as stated in our Student/Parent Handbook: Notre Dame Academy has a school uniform that consists of:

- a gray uniform skirt or uniform slacks (the skirt or pants must be the proper size and length, be zipped and buttoned, hemmed appropriately and free of stains, rips, and/or holes). Students are required to obtain a new skirt or pants if it no longer zips, has tears, holes, or stains.
- a white or light blue banded Notre Dame Academy polo shirt
- socks must be worn
- appropriate, closed toed shoes that have a back to them
- name tag/lanyard

Optional items that may be purchased and worn with the uniform include:

Uniform approved: navy blue Notre Dame Academy pullover sweater, cardigan sweater, vest, crewneck sweatshirt, or fleece (available for purchase through Schoolbelles and some may be purchased at NDA's Bambootique)

- a navy blue blazer with NDA's emblem for special occasions such as Mass, award ceremonies, etc.
- white, gray, black, or navy blue solid colored leggings that are close fitting and tapered at the ankle

Students are expected to be in uniform throughout the school day and to wear the uniform skirt zipped and buttoned. The bottom of the skirt should not be higher than the mid-thigh and should be of an acceptable and tasteful length. *This is at the discretion of the female staff and administration.

NDA encourages parents to check how the uniform fits at the beginning of each school year and to purchase a new one if necessary. Schoolbelles is NDA's official uniform provider.

IMPORTANT UPDATE FROM THE NDA MATH DEPARTMENT

NEW GRAPHING CALCULATOR OPTION FOR 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR

Good morning,

As the beginning of the school year is approaching, the math department at Notre Dame Academy would like to communicate a recent change to all families whose daughter(s) will be attending NDA for the 2024-2025 academic year.

Many standardized tests, including the ACT, PreACT, SAT, PSAT, and national AP math and science exams are now accepting the use of the NumWorks graphing calculator. To help ensure that our students are prepared for these various national exams, the NDA math department will be incorporating use of both the TI-84 Plus and NumWorks graphing calculators in our courses. In our own exploration of the NumWorks calculator, we feel it provides a more user-friendly interface that will help our students establish greater clarity in their understanding of material. The NumWorks graphing calculator (intended to replace the TI-84) costs \$99, but there is also a FREE app version of the calculator for all phones, Ipads, and Iaptops. The NDA math department was able to generate a discount code for any NDA students interested in purchasing this calculator in lieu of the TI-84 graphing calculator. More information about the NumWorks calculator can be found at https://www.numworks.com/. We encourage you or your daughter to explore this option as they gather materials for their classes.

Below is a 10% discount code for any NDA student that purchases the NumWorks graphing calculator. Please note that this link will expire on September 4th.



If you or your daughter have already purchased a TI-84 graphing calculator and prefer to stick with this device, our department is prepared to continue teaching how to perform various tasks on it to help effectively strengthen knowledge of math content.

We recognize this is being communicated very closely to the school year, but we feel it is in our students' best interest to share the recent change made in standardized and AP tests and at least offer this new device for our classes. We recognize that purchasing the NumWorks graphing calculator now may result in students not having the actual device when school starts. Our plan is to have the affected students use the online NumWorks app to buy us time until their actual devices arrive.

Please do not hesitate to reach out if you have any questions or concerns. We look forward to getting into the classroom on August 12th!

FINALFORMS ACCOUNTS

FinalForms Updates Needed for the 24-25 School Year

Notre Dame Academy partners with FinalForms, an online forms and data management service which allows you to complete and sign forms for your daughter(s) online. FinalForms saves data from year-to-year, meaning you will never need to enter the same information twice! You may review your data at any time throughout the year to verify that it is current.

All parents and students are expected to use FinalForms and complete their updates for next year by July 5, 2024 (if participating in athletics) or by the first day of school. FinalForms will be active for the 2024-25 school year beginning on June 10.

Students who want to participate in athletics must upload a valid, signed KH-SAA physical form in Final Forms before participating in any athletic activities, including conditioning workouts, open gyms and tryouts for all sports. **The KHSAA physical form can be found HERE.**

If you do not have a FinalForms account, please create one account at: https://notredameacademy-ky.finalforms.com and follow the prompts to create the parent account, begin your daughter's account and sign your forms. Your daughter's NDA gmail must be used when setting up her account.

Once the parent/guardian creates the account, the student will be prompted in her NDA email to submit her forms. Please note: if you have already turned in your daughter's immunization record, you do not need to upload it separately. School personnel will upload it for you.

If you already have an account for a current NDA student and need to add another daughter:

Login to your account and click MY STUDENTS to add another student to your account and make any updates for your returning student. Make sure you are updating information for the 24-25 school year.




